GARBAGE AND TRASH "DOS & DON'TS

Here are some rules and regulations as well as some tips to help **Keep Monroe Beautiful.**


GARBAGE

- 1. Place garbage inside the City of Monroe provided container.
- 2. Place the container **on your property** at curbside after 4pm on the day before collection and remove it by nightfall on the day of collection.
- 3. Use only City provided containers. No personal containers. If your garbage regularly exceeds capacity, additional containers are available at a pro-rated fee.
- 4. Save space by breaking down or cutting up cardboard boxes.

TRASH

- 1. When on schedule: Trash will be collected on the same day as garbage, but by a separate truck.
- 2. Bag all leaves, vines, small limbs, and grass cuttings.
- 3. Only two (2) cubic yards of trash per week will be collected. A fee of \$15.00 per cubic yard will be charged for waste collected in excess of this amount, in addition to a \$50.00 non-compliance fee.
- 4. Place items on your property within six (6) feet of the area of where the garbage container is placed.
- 5. Tree limbs should be neatly stacked and not exceed four (4) feet in length or six (6) inches in diameter and not weigh more than fifty (50) pounds. Bind them with string or duct tape when possible.
- 6. Do not place items for collection near a tree, utility sign post, or inside a fence. Do not place on or near drain boxes, in ditches, or under power lines.





DO NOT PLACE AT CURBSIDE

Furniture & Bedding
Large Appliances
Water Heaters
Plumbing Fixtures
Televisions
Tires

Violators will be subject to Environmental Court Fines.

RENTAL PROPERTIES

Landlords are responsible for the disposal of items from evictions or move-outs.

Items at roadside for more than a week are code violations and subject to Environmental Court Fines.
